

HIV/AIDS 501 UPDATE TRAINING ON-LINE

Instruction to successfully complete 2020-2021 Miami-Dade HIV/AIDS 501 update renewal

The participant must be a certified HIV counselor prior to participation in the 2020-2021 Miami-Dade HIV/AIDS 501 Update. Annual participation is required for recertification of all HIV counselors and testers in Miami-Dade County and the State of Florida. **Recertification is required to continue HIV testing. If your current certificate expired, please complete this online training; no penalty is applicable this year due to COVID 19 pandemic.**

- **Non-DOH** staff **must create their own account** before attempting to access the course through <https://www.train.org/DesktopShell.aspx>.

To create account on TRAIN Florida:

- **Organization name:** type the first 3 letters of your agency. No agency: type self
 - **Department/Division:** General
 - **Group selection:** State Portal->Click group->Florida
 - **Select affiliation->** Florida Department of Health Non FTE
 - **Select Division/office->** Miami-Dade CHD
 - **Professional:** choose one that apply
 - **Work setting:** choose one that applies (No agency-> other and type self)
 - **Make sure your browser is compatible**
- **Department of Health employees** can access TRAIN through: <https://fl.train.org/DesktopShell.aspx> (**without creating a new account**)
 - The course can be found by searching for **FDOH Miami-Dade 2020-2021 HIV/AIDS 501 Update** within the TRAIN course list.
 - The course is a blended learning series of 4 modules.

- Each module is also followed by an evaluation, which we ask participants to complete.
